

## Friends of the Takoma Park Maryland Library

### Annual Report - FY 03

The ninth year of activity for the Friends (April 1, 2002 to March 31, 2003) was a successful one by almost any measure. We continued to support many of the same popular library programs and services that have been supported in past years, such as the Summer Quest summer reading program and lanyards for children's library cards. This year we also had the opportunity to help fund the first Takoma Park Film Festival, which was a great success.

This year's fundraising efforts were augmented by the unexpected and very welcome support of Robert Patenaude and Doug Harbit of the Davis Warner Inn, who offered to sponsor a silent auction to benefit the Friends. Many Takoma Park businesses participated by donating merchandise and gift certificates, and Doug and Robert threw a spectacular party. In addition to this special fundraising activity, the Friends also worked with Robert and Doug to give away books to trick-or-treaters at Halloween.

Membership dues were up significantly from last year, and book sale proceeds remained steady, resulting in an overall increase in income of nearly 25% this year, though we still fell \$600 short of the amount raised in the 2000-2001 year.

Membership numbers have also rebounded since last year, with 86 households holding current memberships. While this is still significantly below the 114 households in 2000-2001, it nonetheless represents a significant increase over last year's figure of 58 households.

The Friends were also active on the Internet this year, moving our web site to its own domain, <http://www.ftpml.org/>.

This concludes my first year as President, which I could not possibly have made it through without the support of a fantastic board. Thank you all.

My thanks go also to the membership, which supports the mission of the Friends in many diverse ways. Thank you for continuing to make this organization a success as we enter into our tenth year.
